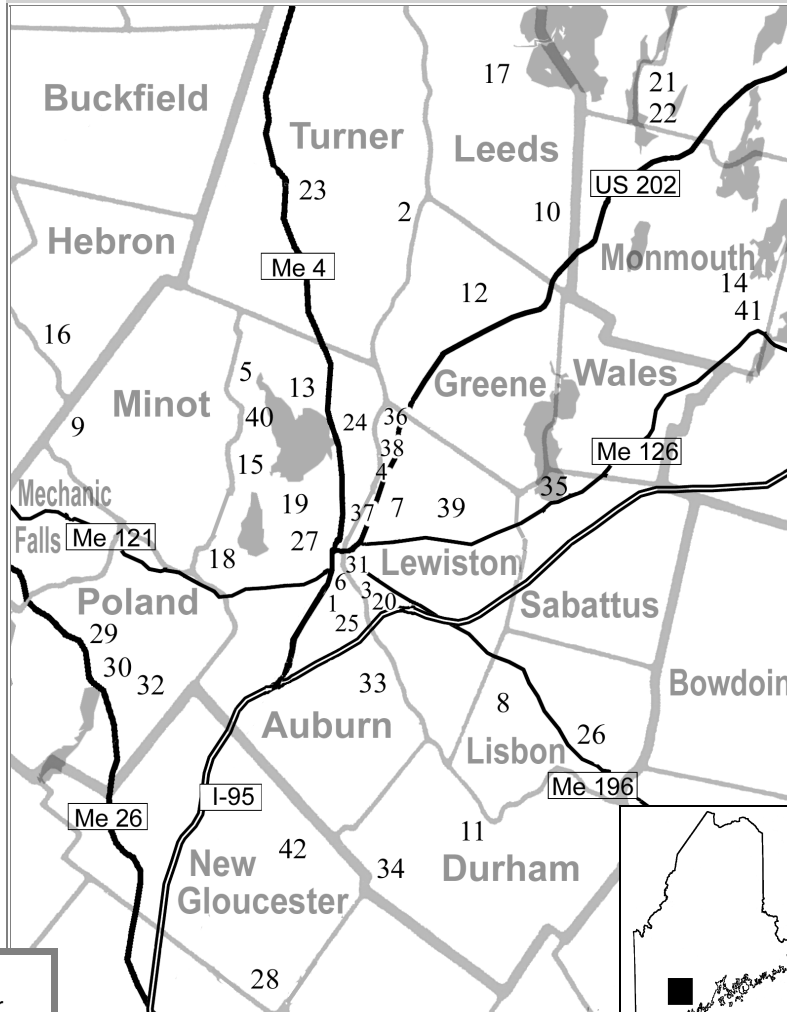


WHERE TO BIRD AROUND LEWISTON / AUBURN



Map identifies site location on the map.

Acc. identifies the means of **access** to the site:

C area can be birded from a **CAR**

E area is suitable for an **EASY** walk

D area contains more **DIFFICULT** walks

K area can be birded from a **KAYAK** or canoe

Hab. identifies the **habitats** found at each site.

☆ highlights the best areas.

These birding areas are open to the public, hours vary, some are privately owned or may charge an entry fee (noted by \$). They are in DeLorme's *Maine Atlas*, or are located by the given street.

HABITATS

- L LAKES**, ponds, rivers, or streams
In winter, primarily the Androscoggin River
- S SHORES** of lakes and streams, or mud flats
- M MARSHES**, bogs, or swamps
- O OPEN** fields, pastures, or meadows
- B BRUSHY** fields, forest edges, or thickets
- F FORESTS**, wood lots, orchards, or groves
- Fc** primarily **CONIFEROUS** growth
- Fd** primarily **DECIDUOUS** growth
- R RESIDENTIAL** areas, towns, or feeders
- A AERIAL**, often seen high overhead

Sabattus Pond is a prime inland location to find shorebirds and migrating ducks, particularly in fall when the water level is usually lowered. The south end of Lake Cobbosseecontee is similar.
