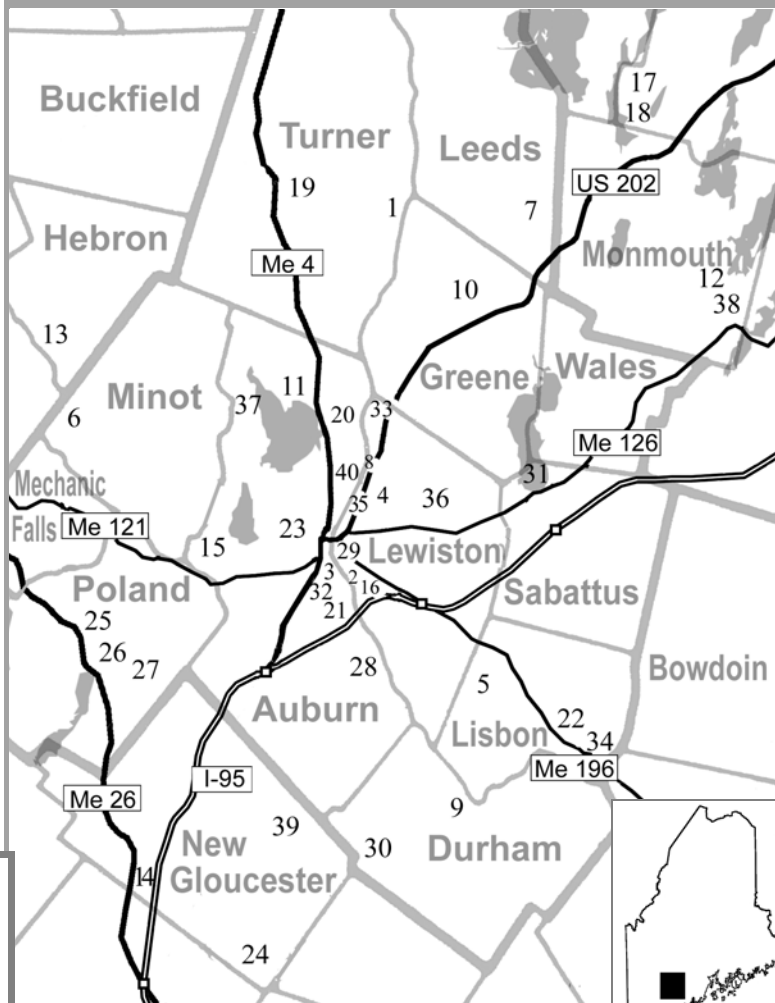


## WHERE TO BIRD AROUND LEWISTON / AUBURN



**Map** identifies site location on the map.

**Acc.** identifies the means of **access** to the site:

**C** area can be birded from a **CAR**

**E** area is suitable for an **EASY** walk

**D** area contains more **DIFFICULT** walks

**K** area can be birded from a **KAYAK** or canoe

**Hab.** identifies the **habitats** found at each site.

☆ highlights the best areas.

These areas are open to the public, hours vary, some are privately owned or may charge an entry fee (\$). Locate with DeLorme's *Maine Atlas*, or by the given street.

- Site conditions vary over time — *use at your own risk.*
- Respect private property, do not trespass.
- Avoid woods in deer hunting season, late Oct. thru Nov.

### HABITATS

- L LAKES**, ponds, rivers, or streams  
In winter, primarily the Androscoggin River
- S SHORES** of lakes and streams, or mud flats
- M MARSHES**, bogs, or swamps
- O OPEN** fields, pastures, or meadows
- B BRUSHY** fields, forest edges, or thickets
- F FORESTS**, wood lots, orchards, or groves
  - Fc** primarily **CONIFEROUS** growth
  - Fd** primarily **DECIDUOUS** growth
  - ▲ *usually high* in forest trees
  - ▼ *usually low* in trees or on the ground
  - no high-low symbol - at any tree height
- R RESIDENTIAL** areas, towns, or feeders
- A AERIAL**, often seen high overhead

Sabattus Pond is a prime inland location to find migrating ducks and shorebirds, particularly in fall when the water level is usually lower. The south end of Lake Cobbosseecontee is similar.
